In this case, the AE Title specified for the SCP should be used and the Association should (?) be rejected if the SCU calls the SCP with a different AE Title.</p> <p>Also the current implementation of dcmrecv's -aet option (which is used by default) and the underlying ASC_setAPTtitles() should be checked...</p> <p>Tested with DCMTK 3.6.7.</p>
