I built the toolkit as DLLs. dcmnet compiled fine, but while compiling dcmnet_tests, the following error occurred:			
dcmnet/include/dcmtdcmnet/scppool.h(266) : error C2899: typename cannot be used outside a template declaration			
No idea what MSC6 suddenly doesn't like anymore. It did not complain while building dcmnet itself. :-/
