Description In the past, Doxygen accepted the use of identical section labels for all man pages in the DCMTK (i.e. for all command line tools). Examples are "description", "parameters" and "options". Newer versions of Doxygen (e.g. 1.8.11 or 1.8.13) report a warning of the following type: "warning: multiple use of section label 'xxx' while adding section, (first occurrence: ...)". This could be fixed by using unique section labels for all man pages. An example is show in module "dcmnet": "echoscu_description", "echoscu_parameters", "echoscu_options", i.e. the name of the command line tool is prepended. This should be done for <i>all</i> DCMTK tools.
