It used to be possible to clone the repository using either <a href="http://git.dcmthk.org/dcmthk">http://git.dcmthk.org/dcmthk</a> or <code>git://git.dcmthk.org/dcmthk</code> , as indicated in <a href="http://git.dcmthk.org">http://git.dcmthk.org</a> .			
However, if I try to do <code>git clone http://git.dcmthk.org/dcmthk</code> , I get the error fatal: repository 'http://git.dcmthk.org/dcmthk' not found. I had a local fork with that URL as the remote, and I stopped being able to update it.			
Cloning with <code>git clone git://git.dcmthk.org/dcmthk</code> works as expected, though. So either the <a href="#">http:// protocol</a> needs to be re-enabled, or the instructions at <a href="http://git.dcmthk.org">http://git.dcmthk.org</a> need to be updated.
