<b>Description</b>			
Sections in doxygen are defined using a human-readable section name as well as a machine-readable section name. Recent versions of doxygen require machine-readable section labels which are unique within the whole project. Otherwise doxygen prints warnings like			
<pre>warning: multiple use of section label 'Tools' while adding section</pre>			
This mainly affects module.dox files (dcmdata.dox, dcmsr.dox, etc.) which often contain the same section headings. An exemplary fix has been applied to dcmnet/docs/dcmnet.dox in commit 9c4ae721a1bc586b315e9aa4e2a0bca5b733bf28.
