<b>Description</b> The CMake GUI on Windows system does not support a single backslash "\" as a path separator e.g. when specifying the include path of external libraries such as "C:\Source\OpenSSL". This is because CMake uses the "\" as an escape character. However, this is not what a user would expect, so this "standard behavior" should be changed.
